

Public Notice: Release of Request for Proposal Wrap Around Services

Kinexus will be releasing an RFP for its Sustainable Employment Pilot on or by Friday February 10, 2017 for wrap around support services that includes the provision of personalized attention and individualized interventions based on specific needs. These needs include but are not limited to childcare, transportation assistance, financial planning, family budgeting, healthy food planning and integration of employment related services with the Michigan Works! Service Center. Funding for this project will not exceed \$190,000.00

Kinexus is a private non-profit organization that will be administering the Sustainable Employment Pilot (SEP) over the course of 12-18 months. This pilot project is designed to help asset limited, income constrained employed residents to achieve greater self sufficiency. The target location for the pilot will be in the Benton Heights community, and will also include residents of Berrien county via referral from employers and community service organizations. Eligible proposers for this service must be a private non-profit with strong affiliations to faith based organizations.
